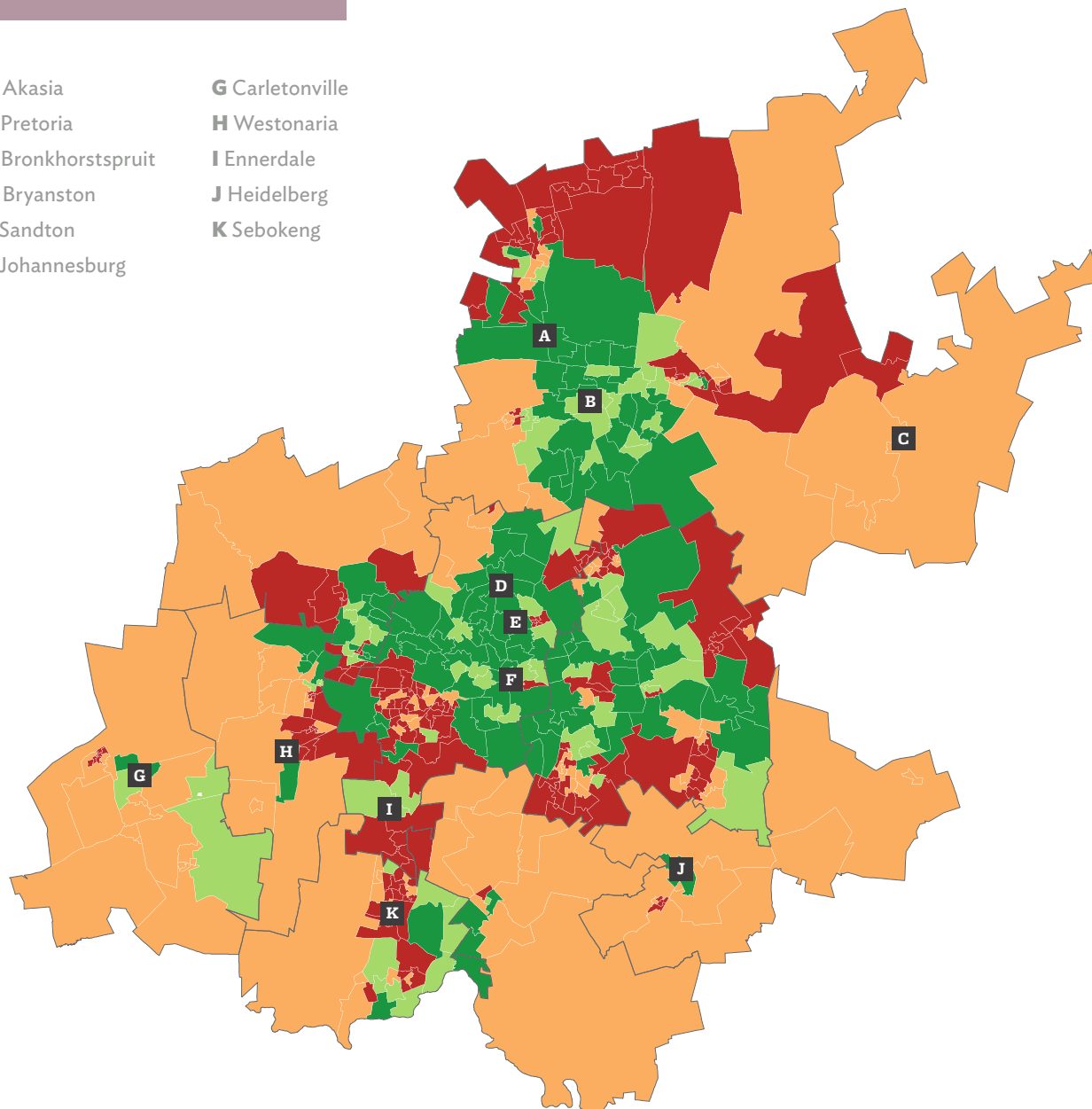

Differentiating household income growth per ward in Gauteng: 2001-2011

- 'Poor' wards with 'low' growth rates
- 'Poor' wards with 'high' growth rates
- 'Rich' wards with 'low' growth rates
- 'Rich' wards with 'high' growth rates
- Municipalities in Gauteng

Note: The map distinguishes between 'poor' wards (wards starting from a low base in 2001 with median household incomes below the provincial median), and 'rich' wards (wards starting from a high base above the 2001 provincial median). Low growth wards are wards in which median household income grew slower than the provincial median growth rate between 2001 and 2011, while high growth wards grew faster.
