


Index of risk factors that increase health and social vulnerability during an outbreak or broader shutdown

Relationship between index of risk factors and population density per ward

- Lower than average risk and population density
- Lower than average risk but higher than average population density
- Higher than average risk but lower than average population density
- Higher than average risk and population density
- Municipalities in Gauteng



Average risk: 38.7%
 Average population density per ward: 5837 p/sqkm
