

The quality of education in Gauteng



This vignette provides a breakdown of the matric pass rates by school type. Graph 1 demonstrates that public no-fee schools have lower pass rates than other categories. Graph 2 shows that districts with low pass rates, such as Johannesburg Central, have high proportions of no-fee public schools. However, this is not the sole determinant as there are districts with higher proportions of no-fee public schools that have better pass rates.



The matriculation endorsement level refers to the type of qualification for which a student can enrol after school.




Enrolment by gender
