
# 16 Backyard housing in the GCR



#### **BACKYARD DWELLINGS:**

- Provide a monthly rental income to property owners, many of whom are themselves poor
- Are a form of densification counteracting urban sprawl

### **BACKYARD DWELLINGS:**

- Show low levels of quality of life
- Represent a housing backlog
- Present service delivery challenges (e.g. how much free basic services to allocate to each property
- May raise health and safety risks (e.g. fires)




